Personal Assistant tickets must be applied for in advance and are subject to eligibility. To apply email access@victoriousfestival.co.uk



We have **Accessible Entrances** if you find queuing difficult.



All toilet blocks across the festival site include a disabled toilet.



We have a high dependency toilet unit on site. If you require use of the hoist please bring your sling.



**Disabled parking is free** to those who bring and **display a valid blue badge**.
